James Bisgrove is a Football CEO who, during his tenure at Rangers F.C. helped transform the club's business operations by significantly increasing revenues and modernising its commercial and sporting infrastructure. former UEFA executive responsible for the UEFA Champions League sponsorship programme, James was also appointed to the Scottish Professional Football League (SPFL) Board in 2023.

During his time in Glasgow, Rangers won the Scottish Premiership, Scottish Cup, and Scottish League Cup, reached the Europa League Final, and qualified for the UEFA Champions League.

In May 2024, Bisgrove moved to Saudi Arabia to become Chief Executive Officer of Al Qadsiah Club, backed by Saudi Aramco, where he is leading the club's ambitious growth strategy and return to the top tier of Saudi and Asian football.

Under his leadership, Al Qadsiah opened their new High Performance training Centre, finished fourth in the Saudi Pro League and reached the King's Cup Final in the 2024/25 season.
